Remember that all children who are not yet 4'9" should use a booster or car seat! This means that all, or nearly all, students will need seats. Make sure to leave your child's seat with him/her when he/she comes to school and pick it up after school. The seats should be labeled with your child's name. Children who do not have an appropriate car seat or booster will be restricted from attending the field trip.

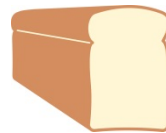
