NEW CDPH MASK GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS

On February 28, 2022, Governor Newsom and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) announced that, beginning March 12, 2022, students will no longer be required to wear masks indoors on California campuses. *However, masks are still strongly recommended.*

The announcement specifically notes that local schools may add requirements beyond state guidance, and any school or district may determine that it wishes to continue to require the masking mandate. At this time, Uncharted Shores Academy will continue to follow the CDPH guidelines as written and plans to cease the mask <u>requirement</u> when students come to school on Monday, March 14, 2022. Both students and staff will be informed of the <u>recommendation</u> to continue to wear masks, and <u>masks will continue to be available to any student</u> <u>as they enter the door.</u>
