

COVID QUARANTINE REGULATIONS

COVID CONDITION	IF TEST NEGATIVE AND NO SYMPTOMS Read 5 day rule below	IF NOT TESTING (even if already had COVID) Read 10 day rule below
COVID POSITIVE	Stay at home for 5 days. Test 24 hours after the resolution of symptoms AND 5 days have passed. If negative, return to school. <i>Bring Test Results Upon Returning.</i>	Isolate at home for 10 days. Return to school after 10 days <u>IF symptoms are resolved.</u>
SCHOOL EXPOSURE	Test on day notified and day 5 from exposure. <u>May remain in school IF test negative.</u> <i>Bring Test Results Upon Returning.</i>	Quarantine at home for 10 days. Return to school after 10 days <u>IF no symptoms are present.</u>
HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE (regardless of vaccination status)	Isolate at home while household members are ill AND for 5 days <i>after all the household symptoms have resolved.</i> IF test negative and no symptoms, may return to school after day 5. <i>Bring Test Results Upon Returning.</i>	Isolate at home while household members are ill AND for 10 days <i>after all the household symptoms have resolved.</i> <u>IF no symptoms, return to school after day 10.</u>
COMMUNITY EXPOSURE* <i>*Vaccinated do NOT have to stay at home if have a negative test. Bring Test and vaccine proof to school.</i>	Not vaccinated: Stay at home for 5 days. Test after 5 days have passed. If negative, return to school if no symptoms. <i>Bring Test Results Upon Returning.</i>	Quarantine at home for 10 days. Return to school after 10 days <u>IF no symptoms are present.</u>
