## **COVID QUARANTINE REGULATIONS**

COVID CONDITION	IF TEST NEGATIVE AND NO SYMPTOMS Read 5 day rule below	IF NOT TESTING (even if already had COVID) Read 10 day rule below
COVID POSITIVE	Stay at home for 5 days. Test 24 hours after the resolution of symptoms AND 5 days have passed. If negative, return to school. Bring Test Results Upon Returning.	Isolate at home for 10 days. Return to school <u>after 10 days IF</u> <u>symptoms are resolved</u> .
SCHOOL EXPOSURE	Test on day notified and day 5 from exposure. <u>May remain in</u> <u>school IF test negative</u> . Bring Test Results Upon Returning.	Quarantine at home for 10 days. Return to school <u>after 10 days IF</u> no symptoms are present.
HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE (regardless of vaccination status)	Isolate at home while household members are ill AND for 5 days after all the household symptoms have resolved. IF test negative and no symptoms, may return to school after day 5. Bring Test Results Upon Returning.	Isolate at home while household members are ill AND for 10 days after all the household symptoms have resolved. IF no symptoms, return to school after day 10.
COMMUNITY EXPOSURE* *Vaccinated do NOT have to stay at home if have a negative test. Bring Test and vaccine proof to school.	Not vaccinated: Stay at home for 5 days. Test after 5 days have passed. If negative, return to school if no symptoms. Bring Test Results Upon Returning.	Quarantine at home for 10 days. Return to school <u>after 10 days IF</u> no symptoms are present.
