Transfer of the student to a classroom-based school will be considered <u>mandatory</u> if at the end of the term the student is missing 10% or more of the days of possible <u>attendance credit</u> or if the student fails one or more <u>academic subjects</u>, even if there has been satisfactory attendance recorded. Students fail subjects when there has been a continual lack of evidence of sustained effort to complete assignments. All assignments must be completed before the end of the term.</i></p>
