Information for Parent/Guardian:

USA groups students according to ability and emotional readiness rather than by age, so all learning groups are composed of multi-age learners. Usually, a student's grade level is irrelevant since he/she can be placed in an academically appropriate group despite his/her grade level. However, in some cases, it is beneficial for a student to be retained anyway. The usual reason is so that he/she will have an extra year to prepare for high school academically and emotionally. Testing at his/her grade level is also a consideration, and it is often beneficial to have a student take state tests at his readiness level rather than age level. This agreement indicates that USA staff, the student indicated in this document, and the parent(s) of that student have all discussed the retention of this child in his/her grade and have recommended him/her for retention.
